## WORLD DAY FOR CONSECRATED LIFE

Feb 5 & 6

Pope Saint John Paul II instituted this day of prayer in 1997 to highlight the gift of the consecrated persons to the whole church. It is celebrated close to Feb 2, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Candlemas Day, when the candles used at Mass are blessed. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus to the world. WE ARE, TOO!

#### MASS INTENTIONS

It is a blessing when a Mass can be offered for someone dear. When you contact the parish office to arrange for Masses, be aware that our parish reserves Masses on this basis: 3 Masses may be offered for the same person on specific dates, 1 being on a weekend or holiday, and 2 during the week. These are scheduled at least 6 weeks apart. Additional Masses for that person will be scheduled when there are openings for Mass intentions. It is especially helpful when Masses are requested without a specific date attached. All Mass stipends are \$10.
