

Or call Amy at 783-0847 or dcapelli@charter.net. This fantastic prayer/discussion/learning program will be offered here at our parish on Tuesdays, 8:15-9:45 am, and at many other parishes and times throughout the week. It is a 10-week series and begins on January 28.

A few folks have asked why we no longer hear bells a few minutes before Masses and at noon and 6 pm. The bell system, given to the parish long ago, has finally given up the ghost. In attempting to reset the tunes played for the Christmas season, the system quit. Repairs would cost as much as this old system to replace. So, for now at least, we will have to check our watch, phone, or the position of the sun in the sky to know what time it is. Replacing the system will be a discussion after the more necessary sound item is addressed: the sound system in church. Depending on where you sit in church, and on the temperament of the old mechanicals and electricals, you have either heard all, part, or little of the homily for the day, announcements of the several community events at the end of Mass, hymn numbers, or the day's Mass intention (not to mention Father Raj's joke punchline). A committee of folks has agreed to evaluate what we have and what it may take to have good sound in church. We have a very patient congregation, and, let it be known, your comments on the sound system have not fallen on deaf ears (just had to say that).
