Mission Co-op, June 12 & 13

Father Honore' Kombo from the Democratic Republic of Congo will speak at all the Masses in our parish on the weekend of June 12-13, 2021, on behalf of his Diocese of Kikwit in the Congo as part of the Mission Co-op. The Diocese of Kikwit has recently celebrated its Centenary of Evangelization (2012-2017). Building on milestones of over 100 years of Evangelization, they take on the challenges to continue the work of the Mission today. Father Kombo will give the missionary appeal in support of the pastoral work of 194 Diocesan Priests to help equip 5 most important diocesan hospitals with medicines and other basic health supplies, and to give children from very poor families an opportunity for education. A second collection will be taken up for that purpose. Thank you for your generous response to his appeal for the Church's Mission in the Congo!
