From the Office of Sacred Worship, Diocese of La Crosse:

According to an October 23 decree from the Holy See, "This year, in the current circumstances due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Plenary Indulgences for the faithful will be extended throughout the entire month of November, with adaptation of works and conditions to guarantee the safety of the faithful." In brief, the changes include:

"a.-the Plenary Indulgence for those who visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased, even if only mentally (i.e. mental prayer), normally established only on the individual days from 1 to November 8, may be transferred to other days of the same month, until it ends. These days, freely chosen by the individual believers, may also be separate from each other:

"b.-the Plenary Indulgence of November 2, established on the occasion of the Commemoration of all the deceased faithful for those who piously visit a church or oratory and recite the 'Our Father' and the 'Creed' there, may be transferred not only to the Sunday before and after or on the Solemnity of All Saints, but also to another day of the month of November, freely chosen by the individual faithful."

BEATIFICATION OF FATHER MICHAEL McGIVNEY

October 31, 2020

Father McGivney founded the Knights of Columbus in 1882 to provide financial support to widows and orphans, and he worked tirelessly to improve the living conditions of his 19th century immigrant community in Connecticut. In addition, he toiled to keep Catholic men and women close to their faith during a time of wide-spread Catholic bigotry. Today there are more than 16,000 K of C councils and 2 million members located in all 50 states, Canada, Mexico, the Philippines, Poland, Ukraine, Lithuania, France, and South Korea.
