HOLY THURSDAY - MASS OF THE LORD'S LAST SUPPER

Jim Bagniewski will be coordinating help for the **Holy Thursday Potluck**, which precedes the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper. He will need folks to set up/clean up, as well as contribute food items. There is an online sign-up on the RNP homepage, as well as sign-ups at the doors at the Newman Center.

**FOOT WASHING AT RNP:** Dave Belland will be coordinating an **all-assembly foot washing** and will need volunteers for each of eight stations. We also need Hospitality Ministers and gift bearers for this liturgy.

**FOR THE PROCESSION TO BLESSED SACRAMENT:** We will need four strong individuals (college students?) to carry a canopy that will protect the Eucharist from possible elements. We will also need servers/volunteers to carry the processional cross, candles, and ciboria. Dave Schreier and William Arnold will coordinate the procession.
