FROM THE DESK OF FR. BILLY DODGE

Advent has begun. What does the word Advent mean? The word Advent from the latin word adventus which is translated as "coming" or "arrival." Who is arriving? Jesus! And Jesus arrives in many ways. 2000 years ago Jesus came to this world in the womb of a young Nazarene woman named Mary and was born in a manger in Bethlehem. Jesus arrives today in so many ways - especially in the most Blessed Sacrament. Jesus will arrive at the end of time in all his fullness. We are an Advent people - we are always awaiting Jesus' arrival. This is an important lesson for us in a culture of instant gratification.

When we wait we can become impatient, frustrated, and then turn to other sources for superficial consolation. These things of superficial consolation become idols - i.e. things we turn to in place of God. Our religion has a toolbox of traditions, teachings, prayers, and worship that instruct how to wait well for The Arrival. During this season of Advent I hope all of us will make the time to reflect upon how God has arrived in our lives as we await the final arrival.


